For nearly 60 years, Echoing Hills has supported thousands of families, friends, and neighbors through our outreach to people with intellectual and developmental disabilities. We believe in creating opportunities for individuals and assisting them in reaching their fullest potential.

Our journey began with Cordell Brown's dream of serving people like himself. With only \$200 and a handful of friends who believed, Echoing Hills became a reality. What started as a summer camp experience in 1967 has grown to include recreational, residential, adult services, and educational programs throughout Ohio.

Our Programs and Services:

- Residential: Community Living provides homes that encourage and foster independence and integration. Two types of residences include:
 - Intermediate Care Facilities (ICF-IID)
 - Waiver Services
- Recreation: Camp Echoing Hills offers a fully accessible summer program, short respite weekends, and travel opportunities.
- Education: EchoingU helps young adults continue their personal, social, and professional growth beyond high school.
- Adult Services: Echoing Connections connects individuals to the neighborhood around them through volunteerism, exploration, and building upon interests.
- Over 500 team members throughout the state of Ohio serving 700 individuals annually.
