
emphasis on personal choices, dignity, fulfillment, and relationships. Again in 2014 we have had the opportunity to put those values into action!

At an event earlier this year I had the opportunity to talk with a family of one of the individuals that will move into that house. She told me her sister was so excited because since she was born, she had never had a room of her own. Her sister is almost 60 years old! Because of the work done last year, 36 people will be moving to homes in the community and many of them will experience the joy of having their own room for the first time in their lives!

However, it is so important for us to remember that success in any ministry is not based on the construction of new buildings, the exciting new programs we start or even the number of people we serve. Success is related to the impact we have on people's lives, both for this life and for eternity.

As we prepare for another Camp season, we are reminded of where we started, the faithfulness of our Lord Jesus Christ and the many people who have been a part of this ministry over the decades. We have seen almost 50 years of ministry, service and continual growth to meet the changing needs of the people we serve. It has been an awesome 'half century!' We know there is much more to do and look forward to taking Echoing Hills Village into the next half century, led by God, encouraged by His faithfulness and supported by all of you as we create opportunities for individuals with special needs to know and experience lesus Christ.




